Your goal in this assignment is simple. Show me some photographs that you think define who you are right now. Now I don't want you to shoot your room or a silly selfie, that is NOT what I'm talking about. I'm talking about your world, family, job, things you care about. Things that make you laugh, cry or perhaps social issues that you think are important. Again, don't photograph a sign or something obvious, give this some thought as to how you would portray yourself. (Example – I like gardening – how would I show that, well the fruits of my labors, the dirty hands of another doing the job, a photograph of all my yard tools in the shed. You get the idea) Bottom line be creative and give this some thought. Shoot 10 separate things or situations!

Remember everything must be new – Images from the past are not accepted and trust me I will know!!!!!

After you have completed the 10 separate images, I want you to select four and separate the best picture and labeled Best. The other three just call them A,B, C etc.

<u>PLEASE! – you cannot upload your images from you Iphone or Smartphone</u>. The file names are too long to be processed through an FTP server and your images will be corrupted. You MUST upload from a computer connected to the Internet and you MUST come through the Waterfox browser!!!!!

When finished turn into me:

- ➤ Upload to me at <u>www.thomhalls.com</u> 4 images for the project and place them in the folder with your name on it, once you gain access.. See digital file submission under on the Contact page of my website!
- Label one of the images your 'best' like this (last name_first initial_best)
- Figure 6.2 Give me three (3) more images labeled (last name first initial a,b,c etc.)
- ➤ All images must be in JPEG format No PNG, GIF, PhotoShop, Raw or Tiff files. DO NOT ATTEMPT TO UPLOAD FROM YOU PHONE!
- ➤ If you can size your images, please do so that the longest dimension is 7 inches by 200 dots per inch.(DPI). If you do not have access to digital editing software, then make sure you camera/phone is set to the JPEG Medium setting on your camera. That should give you a size that will transmit successfully.
- Place these images into the folder with your name on it on the server. To access the folder simply scroll to it, double click and wait for the folder to open.

REMEMBER YOU ARE WORKING OVER THE INTERNET AND DEPENDING ON THE TRAFFIC TO THE SERVER, YOU WILL HAVE TO BE PATIENT. ACTIONS MAY BE DELAYED AS THE COMPUTERS TALK TO EACH OTHER!
